Art & Soul Exhibit 2018 will take place from March 17, 2018 – April 1, 2018 at the Downtown Dayton Metro Library in Dayton, Ohio. The deadline for entries is Friday, January 26, 2018. A juried exhibit, Art & Soul gives artists who have developmental disabilities the opportunity to showcase and sell their work.

The top 45 entries of all submitted will be selected by an independent judging panel of professional artists for this exhibit. The benefits to artists whose work is selected for exhibit include: an opportunity to showcase their artwork to a large, diverse audience; professional framing paid for by event sponsors; a chance to earn income through artwork sales; eligibility to win monetary awards; and much more. On Saturday, March 24, 2018, Partners For Community Living and Toward Independence will host the 11th annual Art & Soul Exhibit Artist Awards Ceremony and Reception at the Downtown Dayton Metro Library.

Entry Guidelines

- Submitting artists must have a developmental disability such as autism, down syndrome, cerebral palsy or other intellectual disabilities and reside in the state of Ohio.
- **The Art & Soul Committee will accept only emailed images of artwork in pdf or jpeg (300 dpi) format. Artists will be notified of the results by email by Monday, February 5, 2018 and selected artists must deliver their art by Monday, February 12, 2018.**
- **For 2018 selected artists, submit your art work no later than Monday, February 12, 2018, to Resident Home Association at 3661 Salem Ave. Dayton, Ohio 45406.**
- No works produced from hand-on-hand techniques will be considered. Entries must fit into the following types of art: paintings, drawings, 3-D art (i.e. pottery, sculpture, mosaics, etc.), photography, or mixed media. Craft items will not be considered.
- Entries must be original, created within the past two years, **and 36" or smaller in any direction.**
- Artists may submit a max of two works, and EACH entry must be accompanied by a \$10 entry fee
- We reserve the right to set final pricing based on framing cost, marketability, and other such factors, as this event is designed to bring the maximum income possible to all participating artists.
- EACH entry must have a label attached stating the artist's name, artwork title, name of artist representative (when applicable), address, phone number, email address and any other key contact information.
- Collaborative works are permitted. If a collaborative piece is awarded a prize, distribution of award monies among the entrant artists will be the responsibility of the artist representative.
- **Entrants must be willing to allow their works to be sold through the event. Entries marked "NOT FOR SALE" will not be considered.**
- It is preferred that flat artwork be submitted unframed. Art & Soul reserve the right to reframe any framed entries.
- All flat artwork must be created on quality, durable materials appropriate to the medium (i.e., oil on canvas). Entries created on flimsy materials will be automatically declined.
- The installation of the exhibition is at the discretion of the organizers. All artwork becomes the property of Art & Soul from the date of delivery until it is returned to its owner or sold.
- Artists whose work sells through the exhibit will earn 80% of the profits. Art & Soul retains 20% to assist with framing and other expenses incurred
- Artists whose work does not sell during the exhibit must pick it up from Toward Independence by no later than May 31, 2018. Art not picked up by this date will become the property of Art & Soul.
