Saturday, April 18, 2020 Dayton Metro Library Dayton, Ohio**



The deadline for entries is Monday, January 13, 2020.

On Saturday, April 18, 2020, Partners For Community Living and Toward Independence will host the 13th annual Art & Soul Artist Awards Ceremony and Reception at the Downtown Dayton Metro Library.

Art & Soul Exhibit 2020 will take place from April 1, 2020 – April 30, 2020 at the Downtown Dayton Metro Library in Dayton, Ohio.

A juried exhibit, Art & Soul gives artists who have developmental disabilities the opportunity to showcase and sell their work. The top 45 entries of all submitted will be selected by an independent judging panel of professional artists for this exhibit. The benefits to artists whose work is selected for exhibit include: an opportunity to showcase their artwork to a large, diverse audience; professional framing paid for by event sponsors; a chance to earn income through artwork sales; eligibility to win monetary awards; and much more.



## Entry Guidelines

- Submitting artists must have a developmental disability such as autism, down syndrome, cerebral palsy or other intellectual disabilities and reside in the state of Ohio.
- **The Art & Soul Committee will accept only emailed images of artwork in pdf or jpeg (300 dpi) format. Artists will be notified of the results by email or mail by Friday, January 24, 2020.**
- **For 2020 selected artists, please deliver your art by Friday, February 21, 2020 to Toward Independence - 81 East Main Street, Xenia OH 45385.**
- No works produced from hand-on-hand techniques will be considered. Entries must fit into the following types of art: paintings, drawings, 3-D art (i.e. pottery, sculpture, mosaics, etc.), photography, or mixed media. Craft items will not be considered.
- Entries must be original, created within the past two years.
- Artists may submit a max of two works, and EACH entry must be accompanied by a \$10 entry fee
- We reserve the right to set final pricing based on framing cost, marketability, and other such factors, as this event is designed to bring the maximum income possible to all participating artists.
- EACH entry must have a label attached stating the artist's name, artwork title, name of artist representative (when applicable), address, phone number, email address and any other key contact information.
- Collaborative works are permitted. If a collaborative piece is awarded a prize, distribution of award monies among the entrant artists will be the responsibility of the artist representative.
- **Entrants must be willing to allow their works to be sold through the event. Entries marked "NOT FOR SALE" will not be considered.**
- It is preferred that flat artwork be submitted unframed. Art & Soul reserve the right to reframe any framed entries.
- All flat artwork must be created on quality, durable materials appropriate to the medium (i.e., oil on canvas).
- In the event of damage to the artwork during curation process, attempts to repair will be made, if ultimately unrepairable, the registration fee will be returned to the artist.
